


# CPE Site Manager Training - How To

<b>Intro: PigSAFE   PigCARE</b> PigSAFE is the food safety component based on the internationally recognized HACCP Model. PigCARE is the animal care component based on the 2014 Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Pigs. PigSAFE   PigCARE will replace CQA/ACA over the next 3 years.	100 <a href="#">View Questions</a>
<b>1. Herd Health Management</b> Developing and updating a Medication and Vaccine Usage Plan with your herd veterinarian is important for maintaining herd health. Keeping good Treatment Records that align with your plan helps to ensure pigs are not shipped to market with drug residue.	100 <a href="#">View Questions</a>
<b>2. Needles and Injections</b> Having Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) that deal with injections, needle usage and broken needles are important for managing the food safety risks that they pose. Accidents can occur when using needles; if they do, you must adequately notify your buyers of the potential risk and record the incidents.	100 <a href="#">View Questions</a>
<b>3. Medicated Water</b> Following the Medicated Water SOP helps ensure that targeted pigs have been treated with the right medicine, at the right dosage and at the right time and that all medication withdrawal periods have been met prior to sending pigs to slaughter.	0 <a href="#">View Questions</a>
